This form of cooperation among ADRION regions and Partner States will enable the public actors to explore whether and to which extent S3 priorities currently being implemented and/or envisaged in national and/or regional strategies differ or complement each other to build a new one at transnational/macro-regional level. Objectives The project proposals shall focus on: o The exploitation of potentials for transnational cooperation in supporting the implementation of a S3 on Blue Growth in the Adriatic-Ionian area, focusing on topics/sectors of macro-regional interest;</p>



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o The establishing and/or enhancing linkages to support macro-regional S3 on Blue Growth in the Adriatic-Ionian area, with a particular focus on exchange of good practices towards relevant institutions of IPA Partner States.

Partnership requirements

EU financing is only provided to financing Project Partners located in the ADRION Programme area. Each project must involve at least 6 financing Project Partners from 6 different Partner States of the Programme area, out of them:

o At least 4 financing Project Partners – including the Lead Applicant- from 4 different ERDF Partner States;

o At least 2 financing Project Partners from 2 different IPA Partner States.

The partnership can include a maximum of 2 financing Project Partners from the same Partner State.

The eligible partnership can consist of a maximum of 16 financing Project Partners.

Potential beneficiaries – regardless whether they apply for the role of Lead or Project Partners – cannot be involved in more than one project proposal per call/Priority Axis.

The potential beneficiaries will be identified on the basis of VAT or other national identified number, indicated in the B section of the Application Form. Lack of provision of the aforementioned information (VAT or other national identifying number) will bring to the exclusion of the project proposal.

MA/JS reserve the right to verify the correctness of the provided information.

If, for whatever reason, two or more financing Project Partners are declared ineligible, the entire project proposal will be declared ineligible.

Topic 2: Social Innovation

Overall goal

The overall goal of the third call for proposals – Priority Axis 1 – Social innovation - is aimed at contributing to the creation of a favourable ecosystem for social innovation in order to tackle in an integrated way the emerging needs and challenges of the area in terms of social inclusion, fight against poverty, migrants integration into society and labour market, demographic changes and ageing population.

Objectives

The project proposals shall focus on:

- The development and implementation of innovative social policies/tools aiming at the integration of marginalized communities, migrants and disadvantaged groups into the society and labour market;

- The fostering social entrepreneurship through development of skills and entrepreneurship competences;

- The enhancing the cooperation among different actors dealing with social services of general interest.

Time schedule and submission

The third call for proposal for Priority Axis 1 will be open from 20 May 2019 h: 15:00 (CEST time) to 29 July 2019 - h: 15:00 (CEST time) and will follow a single step procedure, i.e. full Application Form and requested supporting documents will have to be submitted by the indicated deadline.

Project proposals must be submitted in English language and only through the



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web-based electronic monitoring system (e-MS) available at www.interregadrion.eu
The Lead Applicant need to be registered on the e-MS system to be able to create and submit valid application forms.

The Lead Applicant shall be in charge for the submission of the Application on behalf of its partnership.

The application package for the third call for proposals for Priority Axis 1 also contains the off-line template of the Application Form for information purposes only. The only valid Application Form will be the one created and submitted via the e-MS.

Topic 1: Maritime Transport

Topic 2: City Transport

Topic 1: Maritime Transport - Development of joint approaches and instruments in the field of maritime transport, such as a modern ship reporting system in the Adriatic Sea (Common Adriatic-Ionian Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Information System ADRIREP), motorways of the sea and related ITS (Intelligent Transport System).

Overall goal

The overall goal of the third call for proposal – Priority Axis 3 – Maritime Transport - is aimed at optimizing the efficiency of transport infrastructures of the Adriatic Ionian, in particular with regard to the Mandatory Ship Reporting System in force, adopted by IMO resolution MSC 139 (76) in 2002 (ADRIREP amendments), the Vessel Traffic Information Management (VTMIS) procedures harmonization, the inclusion of IPA countries in SafeSeaNet and National Single Windows (NSW) procedures and data exchange harmonization.

Objectives

The project proposal shall focus on:

-The update, integration and simplification of the existing ADRIREP - Adriatic Traffic Reporting system -for the Adriatic Ionian seas;

-The improvement and harmonization of the safety and efficiency of the navigation and of the procedures to exchange vessel traffic monitoring information among national VTMIS1- Vessel Traffic

Management Information system;

-The definition of joint training programmes for VTM - Vessel Traffic Monitoring -



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operators;

-The implementation of the SafeSeaNet2 and National Single Window (NSW) standards and procedures in the IPA countries.

Topic 2: City transport - Capitalization of technology innovation applied to integrated environmentalfriendly and multimodal mobility services/structures addressed to cities and functional urban areas.

Overall goal

The overall goal of the third call for proposals – Priority Axis 3 – City Transport is aimed at contributing the reviewing of individual and public transport in accordance with the current changes on demography.

According to the European Commission, the European Union is facing unprecedented demographic changes (ageing population, low birth rates, changing family structures and migration); such challenges affect the IPA countries as well. Taking advantage from the opportunity offered by the electro-mobility and the shared mobility revolution, the present call for proposals intends to contribute to the creation and testing of an integrated innovative planning tools for a sustainable city mobility solution in the Adriatic-Ionian region, forecasting future demand for public city transport due to demographic change.

The topic of the present call focuses on:

- Car ownership and individual transport

Car ownership rates increased significantly during the 70s along with low fuel process and contributing to urban sprawl but flattened and declined in some cases during the 90s, coinciding with almost reached

saturation point. Nowadays, the advent of electro-mobility and the diffusion of (affordable and accessto -all) sharing mobility systems do create the conditions for changes in lifestyle and may lead to a

possible reduction of car ownership and a shift to more sustainable modes of transport, in the next decades.

- Collective transport

The observed trends of re-urbanization and consumers' increased preference for walkable neighbourhoods will probably slow down the urban sprawl trends and reduce car dependency. People

living in urbanized areas are provided with several public transport and car sharing options to satisfy their mobility needs, and slow mobility (walking and cycling) is gaining increasing attention. In the longterm mobility patters will inevitably change and people will be relying more and more on public transport, particularly aged population and other segment with reduced driving capability.

Taking advantage of the opportunity offered by the electro-mobility and the share mobility revolution, bearing in mind the socio-demographic changes we have been facing, the overall goal aims at the creation and testing of an integrated innovative planning tools for a sustainable city mobility solution in the AdriaticIonian region, forecasting future demand for public city transport due to demographic change.

Objectives

The project proposals shall focus on:



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- o The development of innovative approaches to improve sustainable clean city mobility systems;
- o The identification of city transport policies better suiting changing mobility needs;
- o The promotion of citizens' active involvement in the development of sustainable urban mobility plans (SUMPs) in ADRION cities;
- o The transnational cooperation between public authorities and their transport entities to improve multimodal and low carbon mobility and environmental quality.

Background

The Interreg MED Programme 2014-2020 architecture embeds an innovative strategic framework coherent with the EU's Cohesion Policy and built upon key cooperation principles where new cooperation patterns are promoted.

Within this framework the Interreg MED Programme Priority Axis 1, 2 and 3 provides for a two-tier cooperation approach:

the Module-based approach where projects' partnerships are invited to develop concrete cooperation activities and better focus transnational territorial impact (see «Interreg MED Modular projects» factsheet of the Programme Manual);

the Horizontal Projects that support modular projects' implementation, allowing for synergies and better results' visibility aiming to reach policy making level (see «Interreg MED Horizontal projects» factsheet of the Programme manual).

The Horizontal Projects' concept



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The concept of 'Horizontal Projects' derives from the previous programming period evaluation and extensive consultation exercise aiming to improve the Interreg MED Programme performances.

'Horizontal Projects' have been established to connect and support the Modular projects' implementation, promoting both, communication and capitalisation activities. Against this background,

they act as a single interface for Modular projects providing the frame to develop synergies and scale up cooperation throughout the entire Interreg MED community including the Axis 4 'platform' project,

PANORAMED and forthcoming 'Strategic Projects'.

They are accordingly contributing to the development of coherent territorial cooperation dynamics fostering transnational cooperation added value within the Interreg MED Cooperation Programme area and beyond.

Objective of the 2nd Call for Horizontal Projects

The objective of the 2nd call for Horizontal Projects (HPs) targets an Interreg MED 2nd generation of HPs explicitly focused on "capitalisation", a fundamental and "key cooperation principle" of the

Interreg MED Programme "Strategic Framework". Within this call, the capitalisation principle entails a very precise content, composed of 'transfer', 'mainstreaming' and 'strategic liaising' activities

(see also below, in the activities related paragraph). These fundamental principles represent the identity of the Interreg MED Programme and are coherent with the promotion of development, of

good governance and supported by the European Union Cohesion Policy 1.

The aim is to move from a networking community of projects into a vibrant partnership, committed to excellence for a sound and measurable contribution into the Interreg MED Programme overall objective and to the corresponding target values (indicators; see below the indicators' table). To reach this objective a highly cooperative approach is required built upon the following main strands:

provide structured support to the Interreg MED approved projects' thematic community (modular and strategic, if relevant) through dully completed Work Packages fully embed within the Interreg MED Programme 'key principles' and the 'capitalisation' principle in particular; motivate synergies and generate transnational cooperation added value at both, thematic and territorial levels, ensuring the widest possible geographical coverage; promote transfer and strengthen capitalisation of the jointly elaborated tools/measures and results that explicitly target collective territorial appropriation and ownership; engage with relevant policy makers and advocate for effective political leverage and mainstreaming;

connect with the other Interreg MED thematic communities as well as with PANORAMED project to improve governance and mainstreaming modalities;

work in close cooperation with the Interreg MED JS and national authorities and



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contribute to the Interreg MED Programme visibility and identity.

Partnership restrictions

Restrictions for Lead Partners (LPs) applicants:

only partners currently participating in ongoing HPs can apply as LPs regardless the thematic community a partner can apply as LP only once, regardless the thematic community.

Restrictions for partners' applicants:

a partner can apply only once per Thematic Community (Specific Objective or sub-theme) including its candidacy as LP.

a partner of ongoing Modular project cannot be at the same time HP partner in the same thematic community, to avoid conflicts of interest with project partners within the same Specific objective or sub-theme. This means that a partner in an on-going Modular project (at the time of implementation of the HP; thus 1st modular call partners are exempted from this

restriction) cannot participate in a Horizontal Project approved within the same specific objective. If this happens, the partner in question should withdraw either from the Horizontal Project or from the Modular project. National Ministries and Regional authorities could be exempted from this rule, if for justified reasons their participation to a Horizontal Project is explicitly requested (to be justified in the application form). This should remain rather an exception than a rule, as the partners of a Horizontal Project should in general be more thematically than territorially oriented.

Partnership size requirements: at least four (4) different Interreg MED Programme countries (EU and IPA) shall be involved in the active partnership of which at least three (3) located in the

Union part of the Interreg MED Programme area to ensure highgeographical coverage and hightransnational character coherent with the minimum requirement of the Interreg MED programme concerning the participating states' minimum representation. The maximum recommended size, for the partnership is seven (7) co-financed partners, including the Lead Partner. No limit for associated partners is established.

The partnership should ensure maximum geographical coverage and be financially balanced securing balanced division of tasks and responsibilities as well as active involvement of all project partners, including eventual associated partners. In order to ensure a high geographical coverage, Lead Partners must include at least one partner coming from a MED country not included in the horizontal project belonging to the 1st call for horizontal projects, under the specific objective (or sub-topic for Axis 1) in which they apply for. In case this obligation is not respected, a condition for approval will be established by the Steering Committee of the Programme.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

The submission procedure consists of two main steps: submission of an Application Form, to be filled in and validated in the MED monitoring system named Synergie CTE, and production of several

Specific Challenge:

Within the specific objective to foster policy development, innovation, creativity, audience development and new business and management models through support for transnational policy cooperation, the cross-sectoral strand of the Creative Europe Programme, shall provide support to testing of new and cross-sectoral business approaches to funding, distributing and monetising creation.

A workshop was organized in February 2019 to discuss the scope and main features of a new action codenamed Creative Innovation Lab, put forward by the Commission in the proposal on the Creative Europe regulation post 2020. This action will implement project(s) at the cross roads between different cultural and creative sectors, (including audiovisual), through the use of innovative technologies. It will also foster innovative cross-sectoral approaches and tools to facilitate access, distribution, promotion and monetisation of culture and creativity.

Two calls will test out the concept on a pilot, experimental basis, under the current multiannual financial framework:

- The present Call

- A second Call for proposals to be published once the Work Programme 2020 is adopted. Innovative technologies can build bridges among different cultural and creative sectors. The role of digital technologies for cultural and creative sector is at the heart of the Commission's #Digital4Culture strategy. That is the Commission's strategy coupling culture and digital, using the digital potential to empower the positive economic and societal effects of culture.

Digital production and distribution in the age of media convergence is one of the pillars of the strategy. The digital revolution enables the creation of new and innovative artistic creations, but also innovative ways of presenting cultural heritage. In the digital environment, convergence of media – in particular audiovisual – and content is profoundly affecting production and distribution models. By using digital tools (including data and algorithms), the production of culture and creative goods can find new forms of expression, enhance cultural experiences (e.g. in museums



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and art galleries) and bring about new forms of cooperation among artists and other actors. In turn, culture and the arts can bring in their creativity potential to enhance the innovative capacity of Europe, both for society and industry.

In the light of this, this action will implement project(s) at the cross roads between different cultural and creative sectors (including audiovisual), for instance through the use of innovative technologies, including virtual reality. It will also foster innovative cross-sectoral approaches and tools to facilitate access, distribution, promotion and monetisation of culture and creativity, including cultural heritage.

Support will be given to projects:

a) featuring new forms of creation at the cross roads between different cultural and creative sectors, including the audiovisual sector, and through the use of innovative technologies, including virtual reality,

or

b) fostering innovative cross sectoral approaches and tools to facilitate access, distribution, promotion and/or monetisation of culture and creativity, including cultural heritage.

The focus should be on the following aspects:

problem solving approach and addressing challenges for the cultural and creative sectors; audiences and the user experience are of paramount importance in scoping the problem; technology is an enabler in addressing key problems, rather than an objective on its own; support innovation as regards the creation, distribution and promotion of creative content, addressing cross-sectoral collaboration as well as the use of enabling technologies is also an objective.

The reference to the harmonised European Standard EN 301 549 v2.1.2 ('HEN')³ in support of the Directive was published in December 2018, providing presumption of conformity with the accessibility requirements set forth in the Directive.</p> <p>Organizations beyond those in the scope of the Directive are also encouraged to follow accessibility best practices and conform to the HEN. By providing online and mobile services in a more accessible way, public sector bodies and private enterprises will reach more citizens and customers, thus reaping the economic and social benefits of web accessibility.</p> <p>Incorporating features in authoring tools or platforms to meet accessibility requirements by default ("web access by default") will provide an effective way to support compliance with the Web Accessibility Directive. These features will facilitate the creation and maintenance of accessible websites and mobile applications, thus accelerating the adoption of web accessibility standards.</p> <p>The objective of this preparatory action is to support the adoption of the accessibility requirements set forth in the HEN when producing content for websites and mobile applications.</p> <p>To that end, grants will be awarded to proposals developing authoring tools or platforms that help authors comply by default with the requirements of the HEN. Priority will be given to open-source or free-to-use solutions and to proposers involving users with disabilities, in particular in the validation process; accessibility of the tools or platforms for authors with disabilities will be considered an asset.</p>



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The expected results of this preparatory action are the following:
(accessible) authoring tools or platforms that help authors produce and maintain accessible content for websites and mobile applications by default, preferably validated by users with disabilities;
easier production of web and mobile content that complies with the accessibility requirements set out in the HEN, thus facilitating compliance with the Web Accessibility Directive;
wider take-up of web accessibility resulting from greater awareness of its benefits;
enhanced competition in the market for authoring tools and platforms with accessibility features.
The solutions supported under this preparatory action should automate as much as possible the features of authoring tools or platforms that provide accessibility by default. Where such automation is not possible, the authoring tools or platforms should minimise the need for technical intervention by the author (e.g. the tool/platform should trigger an automatic request to type in an alternative text description for a picture).
The proposals must take into consideration:
other internationally recognized guidelines and the state of the art in industrial practices on how authoring tools should help authors produce accessible content;
and
how to ensure that the user interface of these authoring tools or platforms is in itself accessible.
